## National Honey Show

**Because of the difficulties some visitors have experienced in obtaining Visas to the United Kingdom, and to help the National Honey Show to help you, we ask that you conform STRICTLY to the following procedure:**

Letters of Invitation will only be supplied for Trade Stand Representatives, when the necessary fees have been received by the Treasurer.

Because of the risk of non-delivery of air-mail letters, Letters of Invitation are sent by e-mail to the potential visitor, so please ensure we have your full email details.

The National Honey Show cannot make hotel or hostel reservations for you, and you are entirely responsible for making your reservation and for all your expenses in relation to your visit.

The National Honey Show suggests that you do not confirm your travel arrangements until you have received your Visa to enter the United Kingdom. **When asking for a Letter of Invitation, please ensure that all those to be invited are listed, that their names and addresses are given in full and are correctly spelt and that full details of their current passports are included. No further names may be added at a later date. Only one such Letter will be sent.**
